paid as medical insurance covering the hospitalization expenses for 170 teaching and non-teaching school staff (current and retired) . We thank our alumni for their generosity and continuous support towards this noble and much appreciated initiative.  
For the year 2022-2023 a premium of Rs. 799495/-was paid for 168 teachers.
