Staff Healthcare Scheme:

The Teachers Welfare Project has been financially supported over the last 17 years by our alumni from across the world. A premium of Rs.6,05,110/ for the year 2023-2024 had been paid as medical insurance covering the hospitalization expenses for 163 teaching and non-teaching school staff (current and retired) with five claims made and received to date. We thank our alumni for their generosity and continuous support towards this noble and much appreciated initiative.

In the current FY 2024-2025 a total premium of Rs.492740/ was paid to cover 156 current and retired staff.
